Prof Bhaso Ndzendze, Associate Professor of Politics and International Relations at the University of Johannesburg, Vice-Dean of Internationalisation, Faculty of Humanities, Head of the Department of Politics and International Relations, Faculty of Humanities. The key question driving Prof Ndzendze's work is "What are the practical and theoretical challenges and opportunities presented by territorial disputes towards Africa's trade?" Ndzendze's NRF-rated research work and postgraduate supervision examines the interaction between trade and territorial disputes — both continental and global (extracontinental) — and Africa's trade. His work also examines how states use technologies to assert their territorial sovereignty and project power, and how, in turn, state power spawns newer technologies.
