- BTech programmes: 30 points in five subjects, including an E symbol in English and a A symbol in Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry at NSSCO Level.
- Professional B.Eng programmes: 37 points in five subjects including Grade 3 on NSSCH or D-symbols on NSSCAS in Mathematics and Physical Science or Physics + Chemistry, and a D-symbol in English on NSSCO.
- Current Grade 11 and 12 learners must apply with their mid-term results.
- Mature Age Entry Applicants are not considered for this school.
