New programme on offer 2025: **Postgraduate Diploma in Development Finance**

The Namibia University of Science and Technology (NUST), through the Department of Economics, Accounting, and Finance in the Faculty of Commerce, Human Sciences, and Education, is proud to offer a new Postgraduate Diploma in Development Finance.

This one-year programme, which includes both coursework and a project component, aims to equip students with the knowledge and skills needed to design, implement, and manage development finance policies and projects. Students will gain expertise in creating micro-level development finance interventions to address pressing financing needs and challenges, as well as analysing banking and finance issues in emerging markets.

Programme Details

Duration:

Minimum of one year, available in both full-time and part-time modes.

Start Date: February 2025.

Admission requirements:

1. To be considered for admission to this programme, candidates must have a bachelor's degree in Economics, Commerce, Accounting, Finance, or other finance-related disciplines at NQF Level 7, worth at least NQF 360 credits.
2. Alternatively, a bachelor's degree in a non-finance-related discipline, a strong quantitative background, and at least one year's work experience in a financial or finance-related role.
3. Applicants may be required to address any academic gaps identified by the Department.
4. Applicants should note that meeting the minimum requirements and applying does not necessarily ensure admission.
