



Self-help Registration 2nd Semester 2022

Self-help/Online registration is only available for current NUST students who are continuing their studies in the same programme that they registered for at the beginning of 2022. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, no registration will be conducted on campus. Students are encouraged to contact their respective faculty officers via e-mail or telephone, should they need assistance with registration.

Dates

Registration will start on 08 July and end on 09 August. There will be no late-registration.

Fees

- **Deposit on Tuition Fees:** N\$4 200 (for undergraduate and honours degrees) and N\$8 400 (for Master and PhD degrees). In addition to the deposit, outstanding fees must be settled. Full Deposit must be paid regardless of the number of subjects to be registered.
- **Deposit on Residence Fees:** N\$4 200 including refundable breakage fee of N\$1 230.
- **Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, students are strongly urged to use electronic (EFT) or direct deposit payment methods.**
- Payments on campus should be the last resort.

Distance Education Students

1. **All distance students** will be enrolled in e-Learning for their relevant courses. Study Guides will be uploaded onto the MOODLE platform in a flipbook file format. The tutorial letters will be uploaded under the Course Material Section. No hard copies will be issued to students.
2. **Compulsory Vacation School at the Main Campus in Windhoek, will take place as follows: Business Applications (BAP521 and BAP621) from 01 to 04 August, and (BAP721) from 03 to 06 August. Computerized Accounting (IAD720S) from 09 to 13 August.** The Vacation School is an opportunity for all distance education students to attend face-to-face classes and engage with their lecturers for a stipulated period. **Kindly note that the above arrangements are subject to change, in line with the COVID-19 national guidelines.**

Process

After payment of your registration fee, log onto www.students.nust.na and click on "Student Kiosk"

1. Login with your Student Number and PIN then click on "Registration".
2. Read and accept the "Rules and Regulations" as well as the "Declaration" then click on "Add Subjects to a Registration". This will enable you to add your second semester subjects/courses.
3. Register and print a Proof of Registration. Students who were not registered in the first semester 2022, must complete a Resumption of Studies form, which can be found on www.nust.na. Email the completed form to the Faculty Officer.
