

Call for Abstracts for the Future Leaders Summit 2022

The NUST Future Leaders Summit 2022 spearheaded by the Department: Student Services and the Department: Management in the Faculty of Commerce, Human Sciences and Education (FCHSE) at NUST will include both in-person and virtual experiences. This Summit is a collaborative research effort by faculty, students and staff of the the Namibia University of Science and technology, the University of Namibia (UNAM) the International University of Management (IUM), Stellenbosch University (South Africa) and Elon University (USA) on Pandemics and Epidemics in Africa.

Background and Main Goals of the Future Leaders Summit

These themes and your partnership will emphasize engagement, partnership and collaboration as we learn with, from, and about each other’s work to focus on what matters most.

Mode of Presentation

As you review the presentation formats and the themes for the Future Leaders Summit 2022, examine the best fit to share your work. You will be asked to select a topic as part of the submission process and forward an abstract of research you conducted. Furthermore, it should include keywords to help aid attendees in selecting sessions most meaningful to them. Final thematic placement will be determined by the organizing committee. Submissions that show clear design for impact on the youth will be given priority. In order to provide greater flexibility and accessibility for presenters and attendees, presentations will be offered in hybrid format (both in-person and virtual experiences). Kindly indicate in your submission which format you prefer to present your research for proper planning.
