NEWC 2025 aims to be a forward-looking platform for scholars, entrepreneurs, policymakers, and development actors to exchange ideas, share research, and foster partnerships that drive inclusive, tech-enabled, and sustainable entrepreneurship ecosystems in Namibia and the broader African region.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Interested authors are invited to submit abstracts of no more than 500 words, which clearly indicate:

- Title of the paper;
- Research problem or issue addressed;
- Objectives of the study;
- Research methodology and data sources (if applicable);
- · Key findings or expected results;
- · Contributions to theory, policy, or practice.

All submissions must:

- · Be written in **UK English**;
- · Follow the APA 7th Edition referencing style;
- · Be original and not under consideration elsewhere;
- · Be submitted in Microsoft Word (.docx) format.

Each abstract will undergo a **double-blind peer review** by qualified academics and practitioners. Accepted papers will be considered for presentation and inclusion in the official Conference Proceedings to be published as a special issue in a NUST Journal.
