Important Notice: Exit Examination

What is an Exit Examination?

An Exit Examination is an examination that may be granted to all students in their final year with a maximum of two subjects outstanding to qualify for their respective qualifications, regardless of whether they have already written the first opportunity and/or supplementary/second opportunity examination in a specific subject in a particular study period, will be allowed to apply for Exit Examinations.

Other Requirements:

- Subject/s must be examination-based.
- The student must have been registered for the subject during the semester which he/she is applying for.
- The student should have been registered for the module/subject, qualified for and written an examination during the period of registration.
- The student must obtain an examination mark of a subminimum of 30% in the last examination to qualify for the Exit Examination.
- Application must be submitted to the Examinations Department before the closing date as published in the Institutional Calendar.
- The application should be accompanied by proof of the payment of the prescribed fee for the Exit Examination.

When will it be written?

- In March and August each year.

What will the outcome be?

- The maximum final mark allocated to students who wrote and passed the Exit Examination shall be 50%.

What is the fee for the Exit Examination?

- Yes, N\$ 1200.00.

Other important information:

Students who applied and were granted access to the Exit Examination, and

- who, **for any reason** whatsoever, does not write an Exit Examination, will fail the module/subject concerned, and no further examination opportunity shall be granted.
- **who wrote and failed** the Exit Examination, must re-register for the subject/module when it is offered again.
- who are **absent** from the Exit Examination, must re-register for the subject/module when it is offered again.
- remarking **shall not be permitted** since all scripts will be moderated, however, rechecking of examination scripts shall be permitted.
