- 1. Attached, please find the final version of the June 2024 examination timetable.
- 2. ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES (EAP511S) FM & PM WRITES AT 08h00, DI WRITES AT 13h00 on the 28th of May 2024.
- 3. PRINCIPLES OF LANGUAGE USE (PLU411S) FM & PM WRITES AT 08h00, DI WRITES AT 13h00 on the 29th May 2024.
- 4. Only valid student cards for 2024 and Exam Admission Letters (printed from the Student Kiosk), will be accepted at the examination venues. Do not write any notes on your timetables.
- 5. No IDs, Passports, or Drivers' Licenses will be accepted at the venues.
- 6. A semester mark of at least 40% is required to gain admission to the examination.
- 7. Lost or Damaged Student Cards (photo or student number not clear) must be replaced with new cards at the ICT Department, otherwise, you will not be allowed to sit for the examinations.
- 8. Practical exams for Business and Information Administration will be written in the relevant labs. Students should contact their lecturers for the exact date, start times and the labs to be used.
- 9. Full-time, Part-time, and Windhoek Distance students write their exams at the Engineering building in Windhoek.
- 10. Distance learners who need to write exams abroad must make arrangements with the Examination Department through email at landima@nust.na and Cc exams@nust.na at least three weeks in advance.
- 11. Distance students need to arrange, at least two weeks in advance, if they want to write at Mariental, Luderitz, Rosh Pinah, Oranjemund, or Karasburg.
- 12. Students with disabilities or special needs should contact the Examination Department at least two weeks prior to the examinations to make the necessary arrangements.
- 13. Cell phones or any other devices with text or digital facilities are NOT allowed inside the examination venues.
- 14. The purposeful entering of a wrong student number on the answer script is a serious offense and may lead to disciplinary action.
- 15. Examination Rules and Invigilators' Instructions must be always obeyed and adhered to. Failure to do so may result in an OFFICIAL HEARING. This may result in an examination being declared NULL and VOID, and may even lead to EXPULSION.
- 16. Please READ the Institution's Examination Rules printed on the back cover of the examination books.
