Master of Hospitality and Tourism Innovation Management – NQF Level 9

This 2-year programme is a coursework and research-based postgraduate programme designed to enable students to critically examine the characteristics and frameworks of the tourism and hospitality business and evaluate the scope for innovation management. It strives to equip students with innovative techniques and strategic thinking in tourism and hospitality, eTourism and digital marketing, tourism policy, planning, and development among other areas.

Admission Requirements: A Bachelor of Hospitality and Tourism Management or an equivalent qualification from recognized higher education institutions equivalent to NQF Level 8.

Mode of Delivery: This programme will be offered on a part-time basis using a blended approach encompassing face to face and online learning.

Postgraduate Diploma in Higher Education (PGDHE) – NQF Level 8

This 1-year programme provides professionals in Higher Education (HE) the practical and theoretical foundation in learning and teaching in HE and helps to create a scholarly, reflective, evidence-based approach to enhance their professional practice. Graduates will become reflective practitioners and educational change agents with strong analytical, pedagogical skills, technological, critical, problem-solving, and creative thinking skills to assist their students in becoming global citizens of the 21st Century prepared for the Fourth Industrial Revolution (4IR) and the job market.

Admission Requirements: A Bachelors degree at NQF Level 7 from NUST or any recognised higher education institution equivalent to NQF Level 7.

Mode of Deliver: This programme will be offered in full- and parttime modes through online delivery options and methodologies in accordance with NUST rules and regulations.
