Supplementary/Second Opportunity Examinations will start on the 1st and end on the 11th of December 2025.

1. Attached is the **final version** of the December 2025 examination timetable.
2. Only **valid student cards for 2025** and Exam Admission Letters (printed from the Student Kiosk), will be accepted at the examination venues. Do not write any notes on your timetables.
3. No IDs, Passports, or Driver's licenses will be accepted at the venues.
4. **Lost or Damaged Student Cards** (photo or student number not clear) must be replaced with new cards at the ICT Department; otherwise, you will not be allowed to sit for the examinations.
5. **Practical examinations for Database Programming and Business Applications will be written on 28 November in the respective computer labs. Students are advised to contact their lecturers for the exact starting times and the specific labs to be used.**
6. **Full-time, Part-time, and Windhoek Distance students write their exams at the Engineering building in Windhoek.**
7. **Distance students need to arrange, at least two weeks in advance, if they want to write at Rosh Pinah.**
8. Students with **disabilities or special needs** should contact the Examination Department at least two weeks prior to the examinations to make the necessary arrangements.
9. **Cell phones** or any other devices with text or digital facilities are NOT allowed inside the examination venues.
10. The purposeful entering of a **wrong student number** on the answer script is a serious offense and may lead to **disciplinary** action.
11. Examination Rules and Invigilators' Instructions must be obeyed and adhered to at all times. Failure to do so may result in an OFFICIAL HEARING. This may result in an examination being declared NULL and VOID, and may even lead to EXPULSION.
12. Please READ the Institution's Examination Rules printed on the back cover of the examination books.
13. Any books, notes, bags, or **unauthorized material** must be placed in lockers / designated areas.
14. The Namibia University of Science and Technology (NUST) does not take responsibility for the safekeeping of any items that candidates bring to the venue, and cannot be held responsible for damages or lost items.
