



NUST Admission and Registration Process for the 2021 Registration

Due to the uncertainties and restrictions caused by the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, **all students, including first-year students are required to register online during the 2021 Academic Year.**

Meeting the minimum admission requirements for a specific Study Programme is not an automatic guarantee that an Applicant will be admitted to the University. NUST follows a Final Selection Process as follows:

Final Selection Process

2020 Grade 11 and 12 Learners/ Applicants

- The University received all Grade 11 and 12 Results from the Ministry and will break it down per Faculty for all learners **who applied** to study at NUST.
- The respective Faculties will do Final Selection based on learners' final results and in line with the admission requirements for each Study Programme as specified in the **Guide for Prospective Students** available on the NUST Website.
- The NUST **Admission Point Scale** for Grade 11 and 12 Applicants, as approved by the University Senate, is included in the **Guide for Prospective Students**.
- Lists of Final Selected Candidates per Study Programme is available from the relevant Faculty's Department, Faculty Officers and the NUST Regional Centres across the country.
- Final Selected Candidates will receive a SMS and Email to notify them that they may proceed to pay the Deposit on Tuition Fees and register online.
- Step by Step guidelines on how to register online is available in the **Registration Guide 2021** and can be downloaded from the NUST website.

- Any student who experience a challenge is encouraged to contact their respective Faculty Officer or Regional Centre closest to their place of residence for assistance.

Applicants with Multiple Grade 12 Results obtained in different years

Final Selected Candidates will receive a SMS and Email to notify them that they may proceed to pay the Deposit on Tuition Fees and register online.

International Students

Final Selected Candidates will receive an Email and/or SMS to notify them that they may proceed to pay the Deposit on Tuition Fees and register online.

Advance Standing, Mature Age Entry and Honours Applicants

Final Selected Candidates will receive a SMS and Email to notify them that they may proceed to pay the Deposit on Tuition Fees and register online.

Master and Doctorate Candidates

Final Selected Master and Doctorate Candidates will receive a SMS and Email by Friday, 19th February to notify them that they may proceed to pay the Deposit on Tuition Fees and register online.
