Final Selection (new students)

All undergraduate applicants for the 2023 academic year, who meet the admission requirements for the programme they applied for, are invited to final selections that will

take place from **23 to 31 January 2023, at 08h00 daily**. Final selections is a process whereby applicants receive "FULL" admission into the programme they applied for based on

the points they scored in the final school examinations. Applicants must be present with their results as well as their identity document during the final selections.
