Admission Requirements

Candidates should be in possession of a minimum of a bachelor's degree and should currently be teaching or should secure a class to teach at NUST. In addition, candidates should request permission from their Deans to apply for this programme. Candidates should attach a letter of permission from their Dean and submit it with the application form. Currently, there is no registration or tuition fee attached to this programme. A postgraduate studies application form can be found on the NUST website, under Documents or you may make use of the application form attached to this email.

Mode of Delivery

Part-time, blended learning approach.

Information about the Programme

- The PGCHE is accredited by the NQA
- The programme has three courses: (1) Teaching, Learning and Assessment, (2) Curriculum Design and Development and (3) Technology Integration in Teaching and Learning
- One course is offered per semester, amounting to three semesters in total
- The class meets once per week, usually on Thursdays from 14:30-16:30, and most of the work is completed online
- The PGCHE has 60 credits (20 per course)
- Due to the demands of this programme, Masters and Doctoral candidates are encouraged to only apply for the PGCHE upon completion of their current studies
