SECTION I: INVITATION FOR BIDS

1. Rights of Public Entity

NUST reserves the right:

- (a) To split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) To accept or reject any quotation; and
- (c) To cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing, and returning:

- (a) The Quotation Letter in Section II with its annexe for Bid Securing Declaration;
- (b) The List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;
- (c) The Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) Any other attachment deemed appropriate.

Before preparing your Quotation, you are advised to carefully read the Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion, but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be **180** days from the submission deadline date.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this RFQ exercise, you should attach the following **mandatory** documents:

- c) Attach a valid original or valid certified copy (valid at the deadline of submission of bid) of Good Standing Social Security Certificate; (certified by a Commissioner of Oath appointed in terms of the Justices of the Peace and Commissioners of Oaths Act. 1963 (Act No. 16 of 1963).
- d) A valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, or proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998, (valid at the deadline of submission of bid) or in

the event that the Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate is over 12 months from the date of issue, a confirmation letter from the Employment Equity Commission indicating that the employer had submitted the report for the period following from the date when the certificate was issued (certified by a Commissioner of Oath appointed in terms of the Justices of the Peace and Commissioners of Oaths Act. 1963 (Act No. 16 of 1963).

- e) A written undertaking in compliance with Section 138 (2) of the Labour Act, 2007 and Section 50 (2)(D) of the Public Procurement Act, 2015 on the Government letterhead (Attached).
- f) Submit signed Bid-securing Declaration.

5. Bid Securing Declaration

Bidders are required to submit a Bid Securing Declaration for this procurement process.

6. Delivery

Delivery shall be within **90 days** after acceptance/issue of Purchase Order. Deviation in the delivery period shall be considered if such deviation is reasonable.

7. Sealing and Marking of Bids

Bids should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name, and contact information at the back of the envelope.

8. Submission of Bids

Late quotations will be rejected.

9. Opening of Bids

Quotations will be opened internally by the NUST immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction eight (8) above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, and the presence or absence of a Bid Securing Declaration will be posted on the NUST website <u>www.nust.na</u> and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

10. Evaluation of Bids

NUST shall have the right to request for clarifications during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared based on price or ownership cost, technical evaluation, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated bid. The Eligibility Criteria stipulated in the bid document will be used to evaluate the bids.

11. Technical Compliance

Bidders shall submit along with their Bids documents, catalogues, and any other literature to substantiate compliance with the required specifications and to qualify deviations if any, with respect to **NUST** requirements.

The Specifications, Performance Requirements, and Compliance Sheet, Annexure A and Eligibility criteria on page 36 details the minimum specifications of the goods/items to be supplied. The specifications must be met, but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.

12. Prices and Currency of Payments

Bids shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars.



ANNEXURE A

TERMS OF REFERENCE

The purpose of this terms of reference (ToR) is to contract reputable **Accredited Service** provider(s) to supply and deliver new Trailers for Namibia University of Science and Technology (NUST). The successful service provider(s) shall perform the required services in line with high quality standards and shall follow all requests and specifications as indicated in this TOR.

Scope of work

The successful service provider will be expected to provide items below at NUST. All trailers must be brand new and delivered at NUST fully tanked and registered with number plates.

List of goods and delivery schedule:

The bidder shall indicate the lead time and delivery to NUST on the Quotation.

Technical Specifications

- The bidder must clearly outline all technical specifications in their quotations on the company letterhead.
- \checkmark The bidder must submit a comprehensive up-to-date brochure for the trailers quoted.
- ✓ The trailers should meet technical standards in EU, SABS or equivalent, confirmed by certificate of conformity with type approval or declaration upon delivery.
- Warranty on body, paint, chassis and other components should be specified.
- ✓ The bidder should indicate the lead time after purchase order in the delivery schedule and Quotation.

Contract duration and fees

- (i) **Duration of the engagement** once-off procurement.
- (ii) Fees 30 days after submission of valid tax invoice and verification of delivery by NUST.

Deliverables

The supply and delivery of five (5) trailers to the Namibia University of Science and Technology as per detailed specifications listed in the Terms of Reference.

Eligibility Criteria

In addition to the Mandatory documents' compliance listed in Section I, and technical specifications stipulated, the bidder should meet the criteria stipulated on page 34 of the bidding document.

Technical Specifications

The goods and related services shall comply with the following technical specifications and standards. For all trailers, the following requirements must be adhered to;

- 1. **Front of trailer** Two white reflectors must be placed on each side of front of trailer, one each on the extreme outer edges within 150mm of the sides (*OR ideally on the mudguards where applicable*)
- 2. **Trailer Sides** At least 60% of each side must have a visible strip of <u>SABS approved reflective</u> <u>tape</u>.
- 3. **Trailer Rear** Rear of trailer must have 2 red reflectors positioned within 150mm from the side of each trailer. The bumper must also have a full length of reflective tape. Chevron board must be fitted.
- 4. **Trailer Electrics** Stop, indicator and taillight functions must be working and clearly visible. Number plate lights should be on each side of number plate. Where side marker lights are fitted, these must all be in working order (wiring SABS).
- 5. **Trailer Registrations** V.I.N. plate (makers plate), number plate and licence discs must be present and valid. There should be 2 types of discs operator's card and Licence Disc + Roadworthy Certificate.
- 6. **Trailer V.I.N markings on chassis** ensure the trailers' V.I.N. has been clearly hard stamped onto the chassis, preferably near the V.I.N. plate.
- 7. Trailer Mud/Wheel guards Must extends across the full width of the tire by at least 300mm.
- 8. Additional rubber mud flaps The gap between ground and bottom of additional rubber mudflap must at least be 200 mm from the ground.

The bidder must provide an official quotation on a company letterhead indicating all specifications that have been met.
