By registering for a programme offered in block mode, students acknowledge and agree to the following conditions:

1. Nature of Block Classes

Block classes are delivered through an intensive teaching format over a condensed period. Students are expected to engage in focused learning, complete assignments, and undertake assessments within or shortly after/during the teaching block.

2. Class Schedule

Depending on the programme, academic calendar, and/or the availability of subject experts, block classes may be scheduled during any of the following periods, and students are expected to make themselves available for the full duration of the scheduled classes, which are not limited to the time frames below:

- Monday to Friday: 08:00–18:00
- Evenings: 17:00–21:30
- Weekends: 08:00–18:00

3. Attendance Requirement

Attendance at all scheduled block classes is compulsory. Students are expected to maintain 100% attendance. However, attendance of not less than 80% may be accepted only where absences are supported by valid and verifiable reasons, subject to the University's attendance requirements.

4. Registration Responsibility

Students must ensure they can attend the scheduled block classes before registering. Students who are unable to meet the attendance requirements should deregister immediately, in accordance with the University's prescribed procedures and deadlines, to avoid being held financially liable for tuition and related fees.
