Competence to develop high-quality course materials and teach in at least three (3) of the following subjects at both under- and postgraduate levels: Architectural Design, Architectural Research Methodology, (advanced) Building Construction, Building Structures, Environmental Technology, Architectural History and Theory, Professional Practice Management, Building Law, Urban Theory and Design. Competence to assume academic leadership, establish professional networks, and maintain links with industry, as well as experience in developing post-graduate programmes. Sound research profile including twenty (20) peer-reviewed journals/books/conference proceedings and successful supervision of at least three (3) Master's and one (1) Doctoral (research) students. Registration with the Namibian Council for Architects and Quantity Surveyors or another similarly recognised relevant statutory professional body is a requirement.

Lecturer: Quantity Surveying

Requirements

A Master's degree (NQF Level 9) in Quantity Surveying / Construction Project Management or a related qualification with at least four (4) years of lecturing and/or industry experience and/or an equivalent combination of relevant professional experience. Excellent English communication skills (oral and written). Competence to teach at least three (3) of the following courses/subject areas: Theory of Quantity Surveying, Construction Legislation and Regulations, Building and Engineering Law, Construction Economics, Measurement, Computer Applications for Quantity Surveying, Construction Accounting, Construction Project Management, Professional Practice and Procedures, Construction Finance, Contract Management, Construction Costing and Feasibility Study, and Research Methodology. Competence to establish professional networks and maintain links with the industry, as well as experience in curriculum development. A credible record of lecturing, peer-reviewed publications, community engagement, supervision of students (research) at the under- and post-graduate level. Registered/ registerable with the Namibia Council for Architects and Quantity Surveyors or another similarly recognised relevant statutory professional body.

Lecturer: Spatial Planning

Requirements

A Master's degree (NQF Level 9) in Urban and Regional Planning or related equivalent qualification with at least four (4) years of lecturing and/or industry experience and/or an equivalent combination of relevant professional experience. Excellent English communication skills (oral and written). Competence to teach at least three (3) of the following courses/ subject areas at under-graduate and post-graduate levels: Demographics and Statistics for Spatial Planners, Community-based Projects, Integrated Planning and Design, Application of Spatial Analysis and Design Software, and Research Methodology. Competence to establish professional networks and maintain links with the industry, as well as experience in developing under-graduate programmes. A credible record of lecturing, peer-reviewed publications, community engagement, and supervision of students (research) at the under- and post-graduate level. Professional experience in Urban Design would be an added advantage. Registered/ registerable with the Namibian Council for Town and Regional Planner or another similarly recognised relevant statutory professional body.

Lecturer: Regional and Rural Development

Requirements

A Master's degree (NQF Level 9) in Regional Development/ Rural Development/ Spatial Planning or related equivalent qualification with at least four (4) years of lecturing and/or industry experience and/or an equivalent combination of relevant professional experience. Excellent English communication skills (oral and written). Competence to teach at least three (3) of the following courses/subject areas at both under-graduate and post-graduate levels: Rural Development Planning, Community Development, Development Economics and Statistics, Rural Development Methods and Practice, Regional Development Interventions, Research Methodology, and application of Spatial Analysis Software (e.g. GIS). Competence to establish professional networks, maintain links with the industry, and experience in curriculum development. A credible record of lecturing, peer-reviewed publications, community engagement, supervision of students (research) under-graduate level.
